AMA Members* receive the following benefits:

Current Members:

• Earn \$20 in Reward Dollars when they register their AMA membership for Auto Renew⁺

New Members:

• Sign up and **save \$20** on a **new** Basic, Plus or Plus RV primary membership (AMA will waive the \$20 one-time registration fee)

Free Associate Membership for Current or New Members:

• Receive one FREE Associate Membership per household if they have any children over 16**

* ECECAF members, belonging to one of nine unions/associations (see <u>www.ececaf.ca</u>), who are also AMA Members. All other existing AMA member benefits apply including "kids go free" for all children under 16. Applies to Plus, Plus RV, Premier, Premier RV Membership.

[†]Members opting in for Auto Renew will still receive a reminder one month before their membership renewal date. The members' yearly payment will automatically be charged to the credit card they register and their membership will always be up to date. AMA does not store credit card information; it is housed by a third party compliant server. Members can choose to opt out of Auto Renew at any time.

How to redeem your AMA Membership benefits

- 1. Call us at 1-800-222-6400 and mention 'GROUP20'.
- 2. Provide your name, employee number, AMA membership number. Sign up for Auto Renew to get your \$20 in Reward Dollars.
- 3. Non-AMA members who purchase an AMA membership over the phone will instantly save \$20 on the registration fee.

How to purchase our New Driver program

It is not a requirement that ECECAF members must be an AMA member to be able to purchase a New Driver program.

All purchases must first be made in full by:

- 1. Coming in to an AMA Centre
- 2. Calling us at 1-800-642-3810
- 3. Going online at AMADriverEducation.ca/New Driver

ECECAF members must first pay in full when registering for a New Driver Program. Students must successfully complete the program with at least 80% on the classroom exam and 75% on the in-vehicle with an AMA instructor.
