

Driver Education Subsidy in Partnership with AMA (since March 1, 2016)

The ECECAF and AMA Process

- 1. ECECAF member registers for a New Driver Program (i.e., Basic, Premium, Ultimate), per instructions in the "AMA Letter" on the "Driver Education Subsidy" webpage.
- Upon successful completion of a New Driver Program, ECECAF member submits "Driver Education Subsidy online application form" (link and instructions provided on the "Driver Education Subsidy" webpage)
- 3. ECECAF issues a subsidy cheque to the ECECAF member*.

Guidelines

- 1. Open to ECECAF members' dependents who are under 25 years of age at the time of completion of their AMA New Driver Program.
- 2. ECECAF members are required to have contributed to ECECAF for 12 consecutive months prior to the AMA New Driver Program completion date.
- 3. The Driver Ed Subsidy application form must be completed (with required documentation submitted) within 90 days of the date on the AMA/Alberta Government "Notice of Driver Education Course Completion" certificate. Upon verification of the application package's eligibility, the subsidy cheque will be issued by ECECAF in the ECECAF member's* name.
- 4. Processing of the subsidy applications takes place after month-end and cheques are issued and mailed by the end of the following month.

The Fine Print

- 1. AMA \$20 Reward Dollars or \$20 registration fee waiver can only be used once per person.
- 2. Students can only receive the Driver Ed Subsidy amount once.
- 3. Members can apply for each of their children/dependents.

*Effective January 1, 2025 for programs purchase on or after this date: If both parents are ECECAF members, the cheque is issued to the parent/member who paid for the program and the amount issued will be for 100% of the New Driver Education program price.
